In order to register for camp, please read carefully and fill out the following for EACH CAMPER, DAY CAMPER and OBSERVING CAMPER:

Payment/Cancellation Policies

• To take advantage of the "Early Bird Rates" for camp, a \$100/per person deposit must be made on, or prior to, the Early Rate Postmark Date. For campers who take advantage of this early registration discount, balances come due 30 days after Early Rate Postmark Dates.

• Registrations made after the Early Bird Postmark Date should be accompanied with full "Regular Rate" payment of camp fees. (*Please do not send a deposit only as full-payments would then be immediately due.)

• All Day Camper Pass registrations should be accompanied with a full payment of appropriate camp fees.

• Cancellations for any program made more than 60 days prior to camp session will be refunded all paid fees, less a \$100 deposit.

• Cancellations for any program made between 30 and 60 days prior to camp session will be refunded only 50% of paid fees, less a \$100 deposit.

• Cancellations for any program made 30 or fewer days prior to camp session are not subject to any refund of paid fees.

• Deposits (from the time they are initially made) and camp fees (once within 60 days of the camp session) are non-transferable, non-assignable, and are subject to refund only within the guidelines set-up in Camp Barking Hills cancellation and payment policies as detailed above.

• Returned checks and late registrations are subject to a \$50 fee.


Camp Rules


Camp Barking Hills places the greatest emphasis on the health and safety of our dogs. There will be many different kinds of dogs at camp. We have dogs of different sizes, different ages, some that have been rescued and some that have histories of abuse/neglect. Some dogs are fearful and some may have been bitten before. These rules are for the comfort and safety of everyone. Please observe all rules when on the Centenary Campus and when participating in off-site activities.


• **DOG ETIQUETTE:** All dogs must be housetrained, reasonably well socialized and non-aggressive towards people. If your dog has been aggressive towards people, please do not bring him/her to camp. Campers are responsible for their dog's behavior at all times. You are responsible for managing your dog(s) and reading the signals/cues given by the dogs around you.

 **PERSONAL SPACE:** Dogs who "need their space" around other dogs are required to wear a **red bandana**. Please respect these dog's requirements. If you forget your dog's bandana you may purchase one at the camp store.


 **PACK SIZE:** Campers may bring a maximum of two dogs. Each dog must have a separate handler when participating in camp activities. There is an additional charge for the second dog. If you would like to bring additional dogs, please call the camp office.


 **LEASH LAWS:** All dogs must be kept crated or on lead when in public areas. Dogs are allowed off lead in designated off lead areas only.


 **POOP SCOOP:** Campers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs IMMEDIATELY whether on campus or off site. All dogs attending camp or on the property must be housetrained.

 **SLEEP OVERS:** In order to be welcome at any of the Camp Barking Hills accommodations, dogs ABSOLUTELY cannot be left loose and unattended in your room. Breaking this rule can lead to expulsion from Camp and you will be responsible for all damages (e.g. chewing furniture, scratch marks, etc.). We recommend the use of crates. If your dog is not crate trained and you have concerns, please call us to discuss it. Dogs cannot be left in cars as cars can become dangerously hot very quickly.


 **AGE REQUIREMENT:** Campers must be 14 years of age or older on the first day of camp. Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times while on campus or when participating in camp activities.

 **SMOKING:** There is no smoking in any of the buildings or during any of the camp activities. Campers are required to dispose of any used smoking products in an appropriate manner.

 **ALCOHOL:** There is no alcohol permitted on campus. There are many places, within walking distance of the campus to enjoy a drink.

 **SWIMMING:** There is no swimming permitted in the swimming pool without a lifeguard on duty. Sorry, no dogs in the swimming pool. Dogs can swim close by at the state park.

 **DOGS IN HEAT:** Sorry, no dogs in heat permitted at camp.

 **WE RESERVE THE RIGHT:** At our discretion, we reserve the right to expel any camper or dog without refund. If you have any concerns about the rules or your dog "getting on well with others" while at camp, please call to discuss your particular situation and needs.

VETERINARY REQUIREMENTS: FILL OUT FOR EACH DOG

In order to help insure the health of all dogs participating in camp, please provide the following records within 30 days of the start of camp. You should also bring copies of these records with you to camp.

Dogs may not attend camp, even as observers or non-participants, without verifiable proof of immunization.

Vaccinations/Immunization:

Camp Barking Hills accepts vaccinations within 12 months of the start of camp OR titers that have been checked within 12 months of the start of camp. The exception is Rabies. All dogs six months or older must be vaccinated against Rabies. This is New Jersey State law. Additionally, all dogs must have a fecal examination, with negative results, within 60 days of camp.

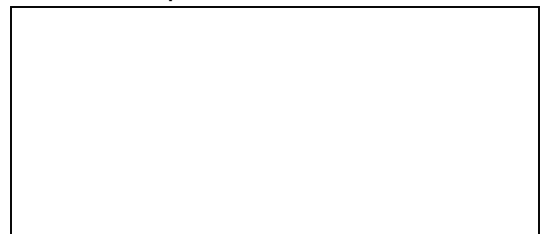
Due to the number of dogs at camp we strongly recommend the Bordatella (kennel cough) vaccination. Please discuss this with your veterinarian.

Additionally, this part of New Jersey has a high incidence of Lyme's disease. You should discuss this with your veterinarian and we strongly recommend using some form of flea and tick preventative (e.g. Frontline) one week prior to attending camp. Please be sure your dog is free of fleas. Any dog found with fleas or other communicable parasites will be asked to leave camp immediately with no refund.
